[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. QUESTIONS

10.30 A.M.

Thirty Starred Questions (Q. Nos. 121 & 150) were put down on the order paper. One question (Q. No.134) was deleted having been transferred to 22.11.2006 for reply by the Minister for Industries. Seven questions (Q.No.121 to 126 & 133) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 22 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.

Two hundred and ninety four un-starred questions (Q. No.124, 133, & 908 to 1199) were put down on the order paper. One question (Q.
