[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. **QUESTIONS** 10.30 A.M.

Thirty one Starred Questions (Q. Nos. 188, 271 to 300) were put down on the order paper. One question (Q. No.288) was deleted having been transferred to 28.7.2010 for reply by the Minister for Industries. Five questions (Q.No.188, 271 to 274) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 25 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.

One hundred and forty six Un-starred questions (Q. No. 824, 1360 and 1453 to 1596) were put down on the order paper. Five questions (Q.No.1462, 1473, 1474, 1498, 1503) were deleted having been transferred to 21.7.2010 and 22.7.2010 for reply by the Minister for Industries, Minister for Revenue and Disaster Management and School & Mass Education. Answer to 138 Un-starred questions were laid on the Table. Materials were not ready with regard to Q. No.824, 1562 & 1574.

The Hon'ble Chief Minister made a statement regarding the distribution of Coal through the O.C.C.F. and the OSIC which is now under investigation by the State Vigilance.

THE BUDGET ESTIMATES FOR THE YEAR, 2010 - 2011

 - b. Shri Sanjeeb Kumar Sahoo moved that "the Assembly do assent to a demand which will come in course of payment during the year ending the 31st March, 2011 of such sum as together with the expenditure already authorised in the Vote-on-Account

will amount to Rs.56,97,30,000 in respect of Expenditure relating to the Commerce Department.

This appropriation has the recommendation of the Governor."
