[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. QUESTIONS

10.30 A.M.

Thirty two Starred Questions (Q. Nos. 198, 243 and 361 to 390) were put down on the order paper. One question (Q No.361) was deleted having been transferred to 24.7.2010 for reply by the Minister for ST and SC Development. Three questions (Q.No.198, 243 & 362) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 28 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.

One hundred and eighty Un-starred questions (Q. No. 1122, 1233, 1462, 1473, 1474, 1498, 1648, 1677, 1840 and 2077 to 2247) were put down on the order paper.
