[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. OBITUARY REFERENCES 10.30 A.M.

The Chief Minister made a reference on the passing away of Late Bipin Bihari Das, Ex-Member and proposed to convey the sincere condolence of the Assembly to his bereaved family members.

Shri Janaki Ballav Patnaik, Shri Biswabhusan Harichandan, Shri Arun Dey, Shri Shambhunath Naik, Shri Laxman Munda and Hon'ble Speaker associated themselves with the sentiment expressed by the Chief Minister.

The House stood in prayerful silence for one minute as a mark of respect to the departed soul.

2. QUESTIONS 10.36 A.M.

Thirty two Starred Questions (Q. Nos. 25, 134 & 241 to 270) were put down on the order paper. Two questions (Q. No.242, 246) were deleted having been transferred to 28.11.2006 & 24.11.2006 for reply by the Minister for Planning and Coordination & Minister for Urban Development. Seven questions (Q. No. 25, 241, 243, 244, 245, 248 & 255) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 23 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.
