[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. QUESTIONS

10.30 A.M.

Thirty Starred Questions (Q. Nos. 391 to 420) were put down on the order paper. One question (Q No.420) was deleted having been transferred to 23.7.2010 for reply by the Minister for Urban Development. Four questions (Q.No.391 to 394) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 25 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.

One hundred and seventy Un-starred questions (Q. No.1503, 1626, 1745, 1903, 1912, 1946, 1960, 1962, 2061 and 2248 to 2408) were put down on the order paper. Three questions (Q.No.2307, 2324, 2355) were deleted having been transferred to 23.7.2010 and 28.7.2010 for reply by the Minister for Health & Family Welfare and Minister for Rural Development. Answer to 163 Un-starred questions were laid on the Table. Materials were not ready with regard to Q. No.2300, 2315, 2365 and 2390.

This appropriation has the recommendation of the Governor."
- b. Dr. Damodar Rout moved that "the Assembly do assent to a demand which will come in course of payment during the year ending the 31st March, 2011 of such sum as together with the expenditure already authorised in the Vote-on-Account will amount to Rs.168,52,21,000 in respect of Expenditure relating to the Co-operation Department.
This appropriation has the recommendation of the Governor."

c. Dr. Damodar Rout moved that "the Assembly do assent to a demand which will come in course of payment during the year ending the 31st March, 2011 of such sum as together with the expenditure already authorised in the Vote-on-Account will amount to Rs.343,93,57,000 in respect of Expenditure relating to the Fisheries and Animal Resources Development Department.

This appropriation has the recommendation of the Governor."
