[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. QUESTIONS 10.30 A.M.

Thirty Starred Questions (Q. Nos. 241 to 270) were put down on the order paper. Two Questions (Q. No.260 & 263) were deleted having been transferred to 27.6.2007 for reply by the Minister for Panchayati Raj and Minister for Industries. Six questions (Q.
