[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. QUESTIONS

10.30 A.M.

Thirty one Starred Questions (Q. Nos.218 , 361 & 390) were put down on the order paper. Three questions (Q.Nos.368,380 & 378) were deleted having been transferred to 28.11.2006 and 29.11.2006 for reply by the Minister for Planning and Coordination, Minister for Law, and Minister for Cooperation. Four questions (Q. No.218, 361 to 364) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 23 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.

Two hundred and three un-starred questions (Q. No.1827, 1924, 1945, 1994, 2035, 2171 & 2799 to 2995) were put down on the order paper. Six questions (Q.
