[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. QUESTIONS 10.30 A.M.

Thirty four Starred Questions (Q. Nos. 242, 300, 330, 368, & 390 to 420) were put down on the order paper. Six questions (Q. No.242, 300, 330, 391, 392, 394) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 27 Starred Questions were laid on the Table. Material was not ready with regard to Q.No.368.

One short notice question (Q.No.1) was put down on the order paper and laid on the Table due to absence of the concerned Member.

Two hundred and forty four Un-starred questions (Q. No.2071, 2118,2140,2213, 2832, 2597 & 2996 to 3233) were put down on the order paper. Six questions (Q.
