[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. QUESTIONS

10.30 A.M.

Thirty two Starred Questions (Q. Nos.494, 530 and from 571 to 600) were put down on the order paper. One question (Q No.587) was deleted having been transferred to 03.8.2010 for reply by the Minister for Panchayati Raj. Nine questions (Q.No.572, 573, 574, 575, 577, 581, 582, 586 & 588) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 22 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.

One hundred six Un-starred questions (Q. No.2644, 2714, 2822 and from 3063 to 3165) were put down on the order paper. One question (Q.No.3141) was deleted having been transferred to 31.7.2010 for reply by the Minister for Sports & Youth Services. Answer to 102 Un-starred questions were laid on the Table.
