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[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]

1. QUESTIONS 10.30 A.M.

Thirty Starred Questions (Q. Nos. 451 to 480) were put down on the order paper. Seven questions (Q. No.451 to 453, 455, 457 to 459) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 23 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.

One hundred and eighty-nine un-starred questions (Q. No.2464, 2880, 3159,3270, 3300 & 3498 to 3681) were put down on the order paper. Answer to 178 Un-starred questions were laid on the Table. Materials were not ready with regard to Q. No. 3512, 3538, 3562, 3566, 3586, 3609, 3618, 3632, 3634, 3635 & 3672.
