**[BRIEF RECORD OF PROCEEDINGS]**

1. **QUESTIONS** 10.30 A.M.

Thirty one Starred Questions (Q. Nos.495 and from 601 to 630) were put down on the order paper. Four questions (Q.No.495, 605, 606 & 607) were discussed with supplementaries. Answer to 27 Starred Questions were laid on the Table.
